TO: STATE ADMINISTRATORS AND OTHER INTERESTED ORGANIZATIONS AND AGENCIES

SUBJECT: Titles I, IV-A, IV-B, X, XIV, XVI, and XIX of the Social Security Act: Availability of Agency Program Manuals


CONTENT: Final regulations to require States to make available to the public upon specific request agency program manuals and other policy materials governing eligibility, need and amount of assistance, and other services.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The regulations are effective 75 days from the date of their publication in the Federal Register: **JAN 28 1971**

BACKGROUND: The proposed regulations, as published in the Federal Register on June 19, 1970, on this subject, were transmitted to you with Information Memorandum AO-IM-22, dated June 19, 1970. Changes have been made in the regulations to specify that the material to be provided for use and review is policy material, and that copies of the policy material be made available upon request to additional custodians based on their interest, function and accessibility to the welfare public they serve.

PLAN MATERIAL: A preprinted plan amendment statement is being mailed to State agencies administering programs under the above titles.
