It is no longer required that issue code 950, which tracks Client Notice System (CNS) notices, be input into the Fair Hearing Information System (FHIS) for CNS notice-based actions. Communications Intake staff should continue to "pull over" notice matches, but automatic insertion of the 950 issue code by FHIS will cease effective August 16, 1999.

In instances where staff enters a fair hearing record for the purpose of adding a supplemental issue, redirecting aid, adjourning or reopening a fair hearing, or issuing a decision and issue code 950 appears on the screen, it will be necessary to delete the 950 before proceeding to the next screen.
