A fair hearing was held at 80 Centre Street, New York, New York, on October 8, 1985, before Jessica Hawkins Greenidge, Administrative Law Judge, at which the appellant and a representative of the agency appeared. The appeal is from a determination by the agency relating to the adequacy of a grant of Aid to Dependent Children. An opportunity to be heard having been accorded all interested parties and the evidence having been taken and due deliberation having been had, it is hereby found:

1. Appellant is in receipt of a grant of Aid to Dependent Children.

2. In May, 1985, the appellant requested a grant of \$3.60 per day for the twelve days that her children visited her on the non-custodial parent.

3. In November, 1984, appellant requested a grant of \$13.50 for child care expense while she attended a fair hearing on November 20, 1984.

4. The agency provided her with an allowance for \$7.00 for child care expense for November 20, 1984.

5. In June, 1985, the appellant requested an increase in Food Stamps because of an increase in her household of two children.

6. The agency has stipulated at the hearing to provide \$3.60 per day for twelve days or a grant of \$86.40.

7. The agency also stipulated to grant \$6.50 additional for child care on November 20, 1984.

8. The agency also stipulated to recompute the Food Stamp budget for June, July, August and September, 1985, based on the inclusion of appellant's two children. F

Inasmuch as the agency has made the above stipulation, there remains no issue to be decided.

DECISION: There is no issue to be decided. However, the agency, if it has not already done so, is directed to issue a grant in accordance with its stipulation made at the hearing and to immediately comply with the directives set forth above as required by Section 358.22 of the Regulations of the State Department of Social Services.
