The New York State Department of Health (DOH) is responsible for oversight of Health Homes, a care management service. Health Home members and potential members have fair hearing rights to contest Health Homes' determinations to enroll or deny enrollment in Health Homes. Additionally, members may contest Health Homes' determinations to disenroll members.

New Fair Hearings Information System (FHIS) agency codes have been created to notify the responsible Health Home. Attached is a list of each Health Home and its agency code.

FHIS issue code 20A will be used to identify issues pertaining to the Health Home program.

Requests should be coded as follows:
